One individualized care coordinator in each county, 6 children per caseload.

**Parent Education and Advocacy:** *Provides families opportunities to develop needed skills to empower themselves, including parenting and home management, advocacy and support with the CSE process.* 

**CR (Community Residence):** *Small, therapeutic group home setting provides structured daily living activities, training in problem solving skills and clinical services.* 

**RTF (Residential Treatment Facility):** *Provides individualized, active mental health treatment to children and adolescents within an intensively staffed residential setting.*
